Both new and existing volunteers may now specify Chinese (or English or Spanish) as a preferred language, as well as indicate their nation of origin within their volunteer profile. To make these updates to your profile, please follow the instructions below:

2. Click the **Update your health information** link
3. Use the left-hand menu to open the **Account Preferences** page and answer the new question to specify your preferred language.

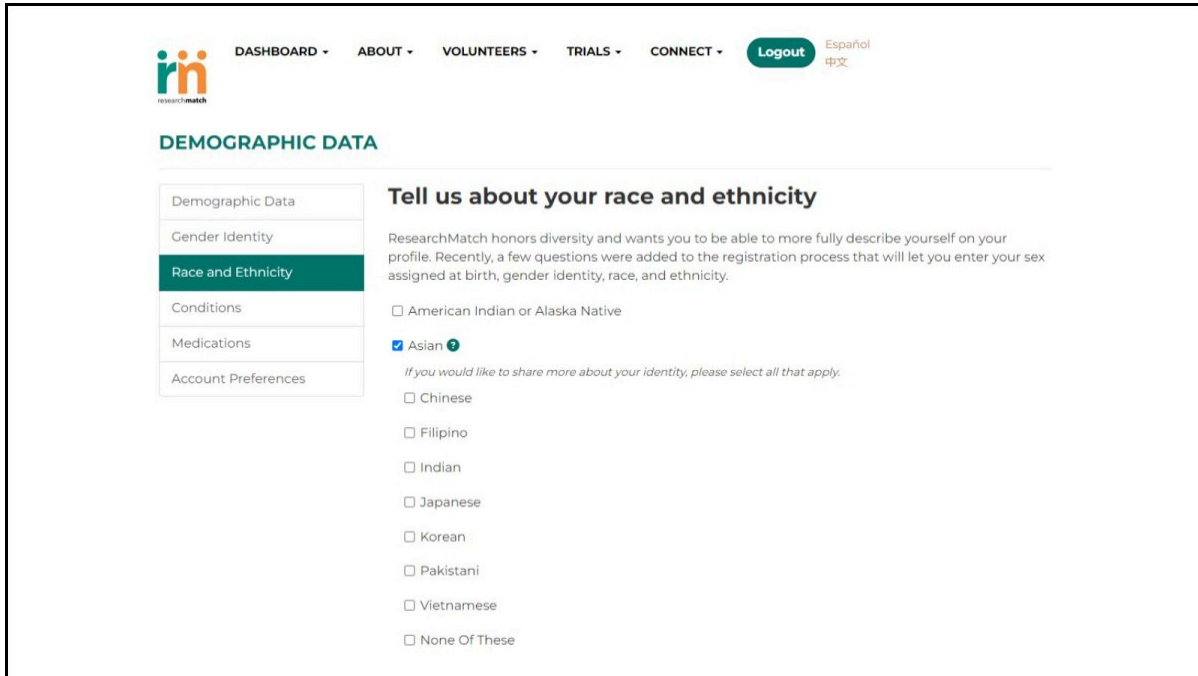
